## USF Awards \$40,000 in Scholarships in 2013

The Foundation made 2013 excellent for many exceptional University of Arizona South students. Four \$2,500 awards, and ten in the amount of \$1,000, were given in spring 2013. The Foundation has awarded over \$80,000 in scholarships in the last two years, and hopes to continue the efforts of providing financial assistance to University of Arizona South students.




A significant bi-national effort to increase scholarship funding was initiated by the Mexican Consulate through the IME (Institute of Mexicans Abroad) Becas funds, with a donation to the University South Foundation in the amount of \$8000. The University South Foundation contributed 50% in matching funds, with an additional \$4000. The funds provided are intended to help increase the educational levels of Mexicans and Mexican-Americans living in the United States attending University of Arizona South.



## **Patterson Observatory Continues to Grow and Mature**





The Patterson Observatory continues to grow in usage year after year. This year the biggest news was becoming a NASA Space Place. Here, children and adults alike can access the information the Space Place makes available, while using our telescopes and learning from some of the best amateur astronomers in the country. We are updating the Space Place wall and also making past posters available for reference later in a readily accessible filing cabinet.

Comet of the Century! Volunteers rom HAC used the Patterson's telescope to image comet C/2012 S1 ISON on four occasions. Those images were submitted to the Comet ISON Observing Campaign (CIOC) and contributed to the cache of data made available to the world. HAC members also utilized the scope to image an earth crossing asteroid for the U of A's Lunar and Planetary Laboratory's Target Asteroid campaign.

The observatory has seen a wide variety of visitors this year. Children, adults, and groups have visited in 2013 and our public viewings have grown to 20-60 people per night. Our biggest night in 2013 has so far been almost 100 attendees.
